In high-risk areas using community-based strategies, a five-day campaign will be conducted with two additional catch-up days. 30 polio cases have been reported across the country so far this year, compared to 74 cases in 2024.

Meanwhile, as a seven-day polio eradication campaign began in Balochistan, Inam-ul-Haq, the coordinator of the Emergency Operations Centre in Balochistan, said 2.66 million children would be vacciented.

"The polio virus is present in the province's environment, putting young children at risk at any time," Inam-ul-Haq said. "Protecting children's health is a shared responsibility. If even one child misses the polio drops, all children are at risk." According to a statement, 11,134 teams have been deployed in both urban and remote areas of the province.

Inam-ul-Haq warned that polio can lead to permanent disability if neglected and urged parents to take their children to the nearest health centre for routine immunisation against other deadly diseases, including measles, tuberculosis and Hepatitis B.

grenade exploded inside a house in the Wadh area of Khuzdar district late on Sunday evening.

Police said two families from Kashmore district in Sindh were living in the house when unidentified assailants hurled a hand grenade into the courtyard. The device exploded, killing the child on the spot and injuring five others, including two women and three children.

Police rushed to the site after receiving reports of the blast and shifted the body and the injured to the district hospital.

The deceased child was identified as Sher Ali. The injured were identified as four-year-old Imam Din, eight-year-old Muhammad Ali, Noor Uddin, Sonari Bibi and Rabia Bibi.

Police said investigations were under way to determine the motive behind the attack and identify those responsible.

Abdul Wahab, SHO of Wadh City police station, said two brothers were living in the house with their families and were working as farm labourers in the area.
